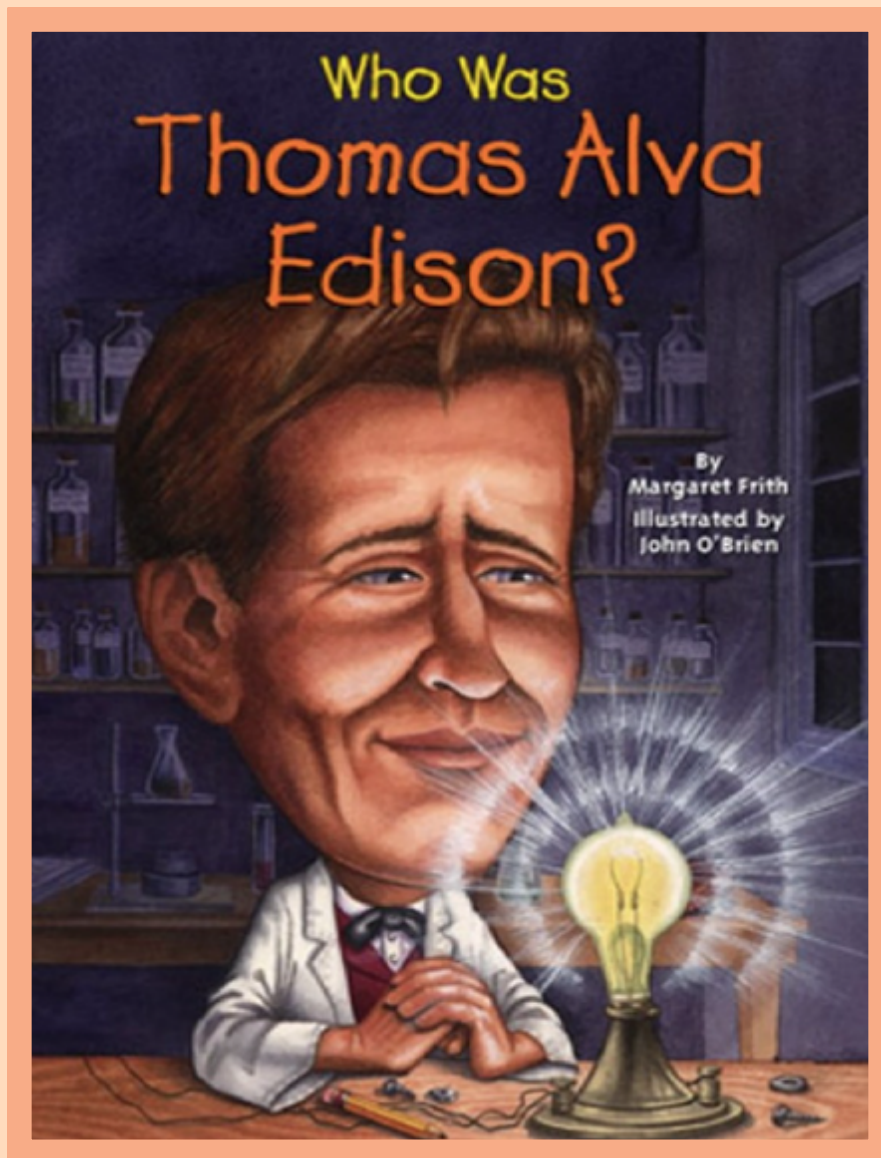


Free Biography and Writing Activities

Narrative Writing
